Class	Description and Details
Beginner Beads: Amon Attwood (2 hrs)	Learn the basics of making glass beads. Age: 16 or older unless accompanied by a parent Max size: 3 Fee: \$5 for glass and fuel
Beginner Stringers: Beatrix Bogenschutz (2 hrs)	Learn how to make simple and more complicated stringers and learn how to apply them to a base bead. Students should know how to handle glass and know the basics of bead making. Age: 16 or older unless accompanied by a parent Max size: 3 Fee: \$5 for glass and fuel
Dots & Eyes: Zaneta Baseggio (2 hrs)	Learn how to use stringers to make dots and layered dots for different effects. Students should know how to handle glass and know the basics of bead making. Age: 16 or older unless accompanied by a parent Max size: 3 Fee: \$5 for glass and fuel
Beginner Beads / Open Torch: Amon Attwood (2 hrs)	Learn the basics of making glass beads or play with what you have learned during open torch. Age: 16 or older unless accompanied by a parent Max size: 3 Fee: \$5 for glass and fuel
Wax Tablet with Hardened Leather Case: Vincent de Vere (2 hrs)	This class will cover the making of a simple wax tablet and a hardened leather case to hold the tablet and stylus when done. Fee: \$5 for the materials to produce a 2 page wax tablet, stylus and leather case. \$2 if you bring your own oak tanned leather.

<p>Simple Shoes for Non-Cobblers: Vincent de Vere (2 hrs)</p>	<p>The intention of this class is to provide members with a process to create a functional pair of period looking shoes for around \$20 in materials. Its intended audience is not those who have great skill in leather working, nor those who are pursuing the fun associated with the most period correct approach to leather working. - This version of the class will include patterning for participants but not the complete construction. The construction will be demonstrated.</p> <p>Max size: 10 Fee: None</p>
<p>Round Drawstring Pouch: Beatrix Bogenschutz (1 hr)</p>	<p>Learn to make a simple drawstring pouch made of soft leather. Minimal leatherworking skills needed, and you walk out with a pouch!</p> <p>Fee: \$3 for materials</p>
<p>Simple Leather Gloves: Vincent de Vere (1 hr)</p>	<p>This class covers the construction of a simple leather glove. Included topics are sourcing leather from recycled goods (second hand store leather coats) and the use of a regular sewing machine.</p> <p>Max size: 6 Fee: None</p>
<p>Saddle Stitching for Beginners: Beatrix Bogenschutz (2 hrs)</p>	<p>Learn how to saddle stitch, a method of sewing leather consisting of gluing, pricking holes, and sewing leather together using one cord and two needles while being held with a stitching pony. At the end of the class you should have a simple leather bag.</p> <p>Irons, awl, needles, stitching pony, leather and linen cord will be supplied, but feel free to bring your own materials.</p> <p>Max size: 6 Fee: supplies will be provided for the class, stitching ponies available for purchase after class.</p>
<p>Cribbage: Ximena Echeberria (1 hr)</p>	<p>Learn how to play cribbage, and some of the history of the game.</p> <p>Max size: 10 for hands-on playing, but more can watch & learn. I have a 3-player game board & a 2-player game board, and each game takes about 15-30 minutes.</p> <p>Fee: None</p>
<p>Make Your Own Nine-Men Morris Set: Mikos Farma (1 hr)</p>	<p>Nine-Men Morris has been played almost forever. Come learn about the game, how to play, and how to make your own board. that you can take with you.</p> <p>Max size: Class Size: 30 people can attend and receive handouts. Will have material for 20 boards.</p> <p>Fee: \$2 for materials and copy costs.</p>
<p>Backgammon: Ximena Echeberria (1 hr)</p>	<p>Learn the basics of backgammon, and some of the history of the game.</p> <p>Max size: 8 for hands-on playing but more can watch & listen. It's a 2-player game & each game takes about 15-20 minutes.</p> <p>Fee: None</p>
